First Lieutenant Kenneth Dee Gilmore FA 5-64 died from gun or small arms fire 31 January 1966 while serving with A Btry, 1st Bn, 21st Artillery 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 166 Days



### **Maximillian Simmeth**

Major Maximilian Henrich Simmeth IN 1-60 died from gun or small arms fire 31 January 1968 while serving with HHC, HQ, MACV Advisors, RVN. He had been in country 141 Days.



### **Stephen Braddock**

Second Lieutenant Stephen Lee Braddock IN 18-67 died from gun or small arms fire 31 January 1968 while serving with C Co, 52nd Infantry, 716th MP Bn, 89th MP Group, 18th MP Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 31 Days.



### **William Busby**

First Lieutenant William Leon Busby IN 3-66 died from gun or small arms fire 31 January 1968 while serving with ADV Team 21, HQ, MACV Advisors, RVN. He had been in country 139 Days.



### **Guy Greenfield**

Second Lieutenant Guy Emery Greenfield IN 13-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 31 January 1968 while serving with 2nd Plt, B Co, 60th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 136 Days.



### **John Darby**

Second Lieutenant John Frederick Darby III IN 5-9-68 died from friendly gunship fire directed at enemy 31 January 1969 while serving with C Co, 2nd Bn, 39th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 29 Days.



### **Irvin Prosser**

First Lieutenant Irvin Willis Prosser, Jr IN 50-67 died from an other explosive device 31 January 1969 while serving with 1st Plt, A Co, 5th Bn, 46th Infantry, 198th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 170 Days.



### **Paul Bowman**

Captain Paul Barkley Bowman IN 8-67 died from hostile fire causing helicopter crash 31 January 1970 while serving HHC, Div Spt Cmd, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 54 Days.



### **Donald Swanson**

Captain Donald Lloyd Swanson FA 42B-67 died from hostile fire causing helicopter crash 31 January 1970 while serving as a pilot with C Co, 158th Aslt Helo Bn, 101st Aviation Group, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 306 Days.



### Michael Arrants

First Lieutenant Michael Lorrell Arrants FA 7-67 died from hostile fire causing helicopter crash 31 January 1970 while serving as a pilot with B Co, 25th Aviation Bn, 25th Infantry Divisio, RVN. He had been in country 17 Days.
