First Lieutenant Thomas York Osborne died from gun or small arms fire 14 February 1968 while serving with C Btry, 1st Bn, 11th Artillery, 9th Infantry Division. He had been in country 96 days.



David Isbell

First Lieutenant David Gene Isbell died from multiple fragmentation wounds 14 February 1968 while serving with C Co, 1st Bn, 5th Infantry, 25th INfanry Division, RVN. He had been in country 104 Days



Ronald Neubauer

Captain Ronald George Neubauer died from a non hostile helicopter crash 14 February 1970 while serving with Hq Co, Installation Defense Command, 5th Special Forces Group, RVN. He had been in country 68 days.

First Lieutenant Marinus Bruinooge was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross for actions on 14 February 1951 while serving as a Platoon Leader with Company G, 2nd Battalion, 7th Cavalry Regiment (Infantry), 1st Cavalry Division, Korea. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2024.

◆ DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS ◆

Captain Craig H Boice IN 9-67 was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross for actions on 14 February 1968 while serving with Company B, 3rd Battalion, 47th Infantry, 2nd Brigade, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2024.
