First Lieutenant Jerry Dean Adams died from hostile fire 18 February 1968 while serving as a pilot with C Trp, 3rd Sqdn, 17th Cavalry, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 138 Days.



Rodney Green

First Lieutenant Rodney R Green died from an other explosive device 18 February 1969 while serving with C Co, 4th Bn, 21st Infantry, 11th Infantry Bde, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 113 Days.



Joseph Marshall

First Lieutenant Joseph Henry Marshall, III IN 14-69 died from hostile fire 18 February 1971 while copilot serving with 48th AHC, 223rd Avn Bn, 17th Avn Group, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He is the recipient of the Silver Star. He had been in country 225 Days.
