

Allen Yeomans

First Lieutenant Allen Calvin Yeomans, III died from gun or small arms fire 20 February 1969 while serving with B Co, 3rd Bn, 47th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 167 Days.



David Head

Captain David Neil Head IN RC2-67 died from hostile fire causing helicopter crash 20 February 1971 while serving as a pilot with with B Co, 227th Aslt Helo Bn, 11th Avn Group, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 314 Days.



John Hunter

First Lieutenant John Clark Hunter IN 9-69 died from hostile fire causing helicopter crash 20 February 1971 while serving as a pilot with D Trp, 3rd Sqdn, 5th Cavalry, 5th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 284 Days.



David May

Captain David Murray May IN 12-69 died from hostile fire causing helicopter crash 20 February 1971 while serving as copilot with 48th AHC, 223rd Avn Bn, 17th Avn Group, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 272 Days.

Captain Ronald A Radcliffe IN 502-68 was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross for actions on 20 February 1972 while serving with Company A, 1st Battalion, 26th Infantry, 1st Brigade, 1st Infantry Division, RVN. He is also the recipient of the Silver Star. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2019.
