Second Lieutenant Clinton Russell Anderson IN 9-64 died from an other explosive device 22 February 1966 while serving with C Co, 1st Bn, 16th Infantry, 1st Infantry Division. He had been in country 154 days.



Owen Emery

First Lieutenant Owen Ray Emery FA 5-66 died from gun or small arms fire 22 February 1967 while serving with HHB, 3rd Bn, 82nd Artillery, 196th Infantry Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 13 Days.



Edward Worthington

First Lieutenant Edward Llewellyn Worthington IN 6-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 22 February 1968 while serving with A Co, 1st Bn, 16th Infantry, 1st Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 23 Days.



David Cavis

Second Lieutenant David Jude Cavis IN 65-67 died from gun or small arms fire 22 February 1968 while serving with A Co, 1st Bn, 16th Infantry, 1st Infantry Division, RVN. For his actions on this date he was posthumously awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 81 Days.



John Lawrence

First Lieutenant John Robert Lawrence IN 6-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 22 February 1968 while serving with C Co, 5th Bn, 7th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. For action on this date he was posthumously awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 42 Days.



Jan Doxey

First Lieutenant Jan Dean Doxey SC 17A-66 died from artillery, rocket, or mortar fire 22 February 1968 while serving with A Co, 125th Sig Bn, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 197 days.



Terrance Bozarth

First Lieutenant Terrance Bozarth SC 2-67 died from hostile fire causing fixed wing aircraft crash 22 February 1968 while serving as a pilot with 220th Avn Co (Recon), 14th Avn Bn, 16th Avn Group, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 26 Days.



William Bobbitt

First Lieutenant William E G Bobbitt IN 3-67 died from gun or small arms fire 22 February 1968 while serving with C Co, 1st Bn, 27th Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 47 Days.



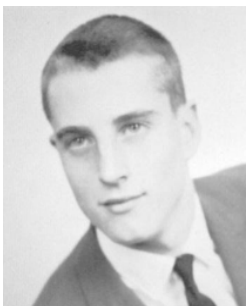
Danny Gilstrap

Second Lieutenant Danny Lynn Gilstrap FA 8-67 died from gun or small arms fire 22 February 1968 while serving with HHB, 1st Bn, 8th Artillery, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 50 Days.



Carl Kozma

First Lieutenant Carl Noel Kozma IN 4-68 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 22 February 1969 while serving with A Co, 4th Bn, 47th Infantry, 9th Infantry, RVN. He had been in country 34 Days.



Frederick Kulicke

First Lieutenant Frederick W Kulicke, III IN 501-68 died from gun or small arms fire 22 February 1969 while serving with C Co, 2nd Bn, 39th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 49 Days.



Gerald Wrazen

Captain Gerald Wrazen IN 10-64 died from gun or small arms fire 22 February 1969 while serving with D Co, 3rd Bn, 506th Infantry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 250 Days.



William McConnell

Major William C McConnell, IV IN AR1-58 died from hostile fire wounds while passenger in a helicopter February 1970 while serving with HHC, 2nd Bn, 12th Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 33 days.
