Second Lieutenant James Howard Scott died from multiple fragmentation wounds 5 February 1967 while serving with A Co, 2nd Bn, 60th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 65 Days.



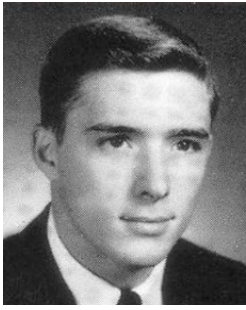
Joseph Burgett

Second Lieutenant Joseph Scott Burgett died from gun or small arms fire 5 February 1968 while serving with 1st Plt, B Co, 3rd Bn, 7th Infantry, 199th Infantry Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 52 Days.



Michael Lane

First Lieutenant Michael S Lane died from a non hostile helicopter crash 5 February 1968 while serving as pilot with with A Co, 227th Aslt Helo Bn, 11th Avn Group, 1st Cavalry Division, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 92 Days.



Harold Kram

Second Lieutenant Harold Andrew Kram, Jr died from gun or small arms fire 5 February 1968 while serving with C Co, 1st Bn, 22nd Infantry, 4th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 24 Days.



William West

First Lieutenant William Edward West IN 110-66 died from gun or small arms fire 5 February 1968 while serving with HHC, 1st Bn, 22nd Infantry, 4th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 338 Days.



Russell Reinel

Captain Russell Edward Reinel died from an other explosive device 5 February 1969 while serving with B Co, 1st Bn, 26th Infantry, 1st Infantry Division, RVN. He is the recipient of the Silver Star. He had been in country 93 Days.
