## KIAs — March 1



### **Richard Petrie**

Second Lieutenant Richard Jeffrey Petrie IN 24-67 died from gun or small arms fire 1 March 1968 while serving HHC, 3rd Bn, 47th Infantry, 8th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 134 Days.



### **John Simmons**

Second Lieutenant John Stephen Simmons IN 26-67 died from an other explosive device 1 March 1968 while serving with B Co, 4th Bn, 47th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 23 Days.



### **Terrance Bowell**

First Lieutenant Terrance Lee Bowell IN 26-67 died from an other explosive device 1 March 1968 while serving with 2nd Plt, A Co, 3rd Bn, 7th Infantry, 199th Infantry Brigade, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 62 Days.



### Jeffrey O'Brien

Major Jeffrey R. O'Brien FO 9-12 died from a drone attack 1 March 2026 while serving with the 103rd Sustainment Command, Kuwait. Operation Epic Fury.

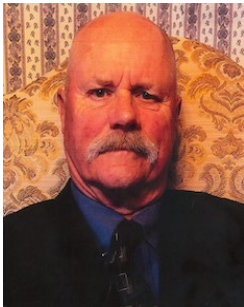
## Valor Awards — March 1



### Frank Pina

◆ DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS ◆

Captain Frank David Pina IN 6-63 was posthumously awarded the Distinguished Cross for actions on 1 March 1968 while serving with A Co, 3rd Bn, 60th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2024.



### Mark Holbrook

◆ DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS ◆

Captain Mark L Holbrook AR 12-67 was awarded the Distinguished Cross for actions on 1 March 1968 while serving with Troop A, 7th Squadron, 17th Air Cavalry Regiment, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2020.
