First Lieutenant Harry Ray Stewart IN 1-66 died from an other explosive device 10 March 1967 while serving with C Co, 2nd Bn, 27th Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 86 Days.

Second Lieutenant Roger William Rabey QM 16-66 died from a non hostile fixed wing aircraft accident 10 March 1967 while serving with I Corps, Adv Team, HQ, MACV Advisors, RVN. He had been in country 205 Days.



Raymond Dubbs

First Lieutenant Raymond Arthur Dubbs AR 8-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 10 March 1968 while serving with HHT, 3rd Sqdn, 4th Cavalry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 58 Days.

First Lieutenant Edward Ralph Meierotto FA 17-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 10 March 1969 while serving with Mobile Adv Team III-63, Adv Team 89, MACV Advisors, MACV, RVN. He had been in country 385 Days.

Major Robert Gordon Cozart, Jr FA 34B-67 died from non-hostile aircraft loss 20 March 1970 (identified 27 Feb 1979) while serving as a pilot with HHC, 214th AVN BN, 164th AVN GROUP, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 195 Days.



Carroll Spragins

Captain Carroll Wayne Spragins IN 59-67 died from non hostile homicide 10 March 1970 while serving with 272nd MP Co, I Field Force, RVN. He had been in country 428 Days.
