**Harry Michael**

Second Lieutenant Harry J Michael IN 380-44 died from small arms fire on 14 March 1945 while serving with Company L, 3rd Battalion, 318th Infantry Regiment, 80th Infantry Division, Germany. For action on this date he was posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor.



**Thomas Kolinski**

Second Lieutenant Thomas George Kolinski IN 28-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 14 March 1968 while serving with A Co, 2nd Bn, 14th Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 66 Days.



**Larry Welch**

Second Lieutenant Larry Eugene Welch FA 17-67 died from gun or small arms fire 14 March 1968 while serving with B Btry, 7th Bn, 11th Artillery, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 42 Days.



**Harry Michael**

Second Lieutenant Harry J Michael IN 380-44 was posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor for actions on 14 March 1945 while serving with Company L, 3rd Battalion, 318th Infantry Regiment, 80th Infantry Division, Germany. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2022.
