Charles Sanders

Second Lieutenant Charles William Sanders IN 9-66 died from gun or small arms fire 18 March 1967 while serving with C Co, 2nd Bn, 47th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 59 Days.



Jimmy Sherrill

Second Lieutenant Jimmy L Sherrill IN 46-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 18 March 1968 while serving with D Co, 3rd Bn, 187th Infantry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 108 Days.



Charles Asselta

First Lieutenant Charles Carl Asselta FA 9-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 18 March 1968 while serving with A BTRY, 2nd BN, 4th Artillery, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 72 Days.



Larry Fitzsimmons

First Lieutenant Larry Lee Fitzsimmons IN 20-66 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 18 March 1968 while serving with D Co, 1st Bn, 26th Infantry, 1st Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 108 Days.



Robert Baldwin

First Lieutenant Robert Lloyd Baldwin IN 54-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 18 March 1969 while serving with B Co, 1st Bn, 20th Infantry, 11th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 186 Days.



Hardy Calloway

First Lieutenant Hardy Eugene Calloway AR 1-68 died from hostile causing helicopter crash 18 March 1969 while serving as a pilot with B TRP, 3rd WADN, 17th Cavalry, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He was the recipient of the Distinguished Flying Cross He had been in country 37 Days.



Richard Ford

First Lieutenant Richard William Ford IN 25-69 died from a non-hostile accident destroying mortar rounds 18 March 1971 while serving with E Co, 1st Bn, 5th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 205 Days.
