Second Lieutenant Charles William Brown IN 10-65 died from gun or small arms fire 20 March 1967 while serving with a Co, 3rd Bn, 39th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 97 Days.



Leslie Sayre

First Lieutenant Leslie Berkley Sayre TC 24-66 died from hostile fire causing aircraft crash 20 March 1968 while serving as a pilot with 221st AVN CO, 307th AVN BN, 164th Aviation Group, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He was the recipient of the Distinguished Flying Cross. Days in country not reported.



Franklin Speight

Second Lieutenant Franklin Elliott Speight IN 26-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 20 March 1968 while serving with C Co, 3rd Bn, 503rd Infantry, 173rd Abn Bde, RVN. He had been in country 118 Days.



John Dugan

First Lieutenant John Francis Dugan FA 36A-67 died from hostile fire causing helicopter crash 20 March 1971 while serving as a pilot with B Co, 101st AVN BN, 101st AVN GROUP, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He was the recipient of the Distinguished Flying Cross and Silver Star. He had been in country 195 Days.
