**Francis Boyle**

Second Lieutenant Francis Michael Boyle FA 5-65 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 22 March 1966 while serving with A Btry, 2nd Bn, 13th Artillery, 23rd Arty Group, II Field Force, RVN. He had been in country 153 Days.



**George Rusnak**

Captain George B Rusnak FA 7-64 died from hostile fire causing aircraft crash 22 March 1967 while serving with B TRP, 1st SQDN, 9th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 173 Days.



**Thomas Shannon**

Second Lieutenant Thomas E Shannon FA 18-66 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 22 March 1967 while serving with A BTRY, 6th BN, 29th Artillery, 4th Infantry Division, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 188 Days.



### **Jeffrey Hamilton**

First Lieutenant Jeffrey G Hamilton IN 19-67 died from gun or small arms fire 22 March 1968 while serving with B Co, 1st Bn, 7th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 137 Days.



### **Frank Spiers**

Captain Frank Spiers IN 3-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 22 March 1969 while serving with C Co, 1st Bn, 2nd Infantry, 1st Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 139 Days.



### **Tony Buholtz**

First Lieutenant Tony Lee Buholtz AR 27-67 died from an air loss 22 March 1969 while serving with A TRP, 1st SQDN, 9th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 128 Days.
