#### **Michael Gandy**

Second Lieutenant Michael Lee Gandy IN 24-67 died from gun or small arms fire 29 March 1968 while serving with Company B, 1st Battalion (Airborne), 501st Airborne Infantry Regiment, 2nd Brigade, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross. He had been in country 146 Days.



#### **Michael Rose**

First Lieutenant Michael Allan Rose IN 20-67 died from an other explosive device 29 March 1968 while serving with HHC, 2nd Bn, 14th Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 146 Days.



#### **James Claybaugh**

Second Lieutenant James Bradley Claybaugh IN 2-68 died from gun or small arms fire 29 March 1968 while serving with D Co, 3rd Bn, 1st Infantry, 11th Infantry Bde, Americal Division RVN. He had been in country 87 Days.



### **Victor Pritchard**

First Lieutenant Victor H Pritchard AR 65-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 29 March 1969 while serving with C Co, 4th Bn, 23rd Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 170 Days.



### **Charles Edwards**

Captain Charles Harold Edwards FA 9-66 died from air loss 29 March 1968 while serving with 175th AHC, 214th Avn Bn, 164th Avn Group, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 87 Days.

Second Lieutenant Michael L Gandy IN 24-67 was awarded the Distinguished Cross for actions on 29 March 1968 while serving with Company B, 1st Battalion (Airborne), 501st Airborne Infantry Regiment, 2nd Brigade, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2024.
