#### Frank Pina

Captain Frank David Pina IN 6-63 died from gun or small arms fire 1 March 1968 while serving with A Co, 3rd Bn, 60th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross. He had been in country 128 Days.



#### Robert Sovizal

Second Lieutenant Robert James Sovizal EN 19-67 died from gun or small arms fire 3 March 1968 while serving with Team 11, 41st Civil Affairs Company, I Field Force RVN. He was the recipient of the Bronze Star w V. He had been in country 236 days. .



#### Frank Dimmitt

Captain Frank Robert Dimmitt IN 8-64 died from hostile fire 3 March 1968 while passenger on aircraft serving with HHC, 1st Bn, 502nd Infantry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 80 Days.



### **Harry Harrison**

First Lieutenant Harry Todd Harrison FA 36A-67 died from a non-hostile aircraft accident 3 March 1968 while serving with B Btry, 6th Bn, 77th Artillery, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He was the recipient of the Bronze Star w V. He had been in country 231 Days.



### **Albert Dismuke**

First Lieutenant Lieutenant Albert Royce Dismuke IN 19-66 died from gun or small arms fire 2 March 1968 while serving with B Co, 2nd Bn, 60th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 111 Days.



### **Robert Griffith**

First Lieutenant Robert Elwin Griffith IN 61-67 died from gun or small arms fire 3 March 1969 while serving with 2nd Plt, A Co, 3rd Bn, 8th Infantry, 4th Infantry Division, RVN. He was the recipient of the Silver Star. He had been in country 135 Days.



### **Raul Alvarado**

First Lieutenant Raul Alvarado, Jr IN 70-67 died from gun or small arms fire 3 March 1969 while serving with C Co, 1st Bn, 52nd Infantry, 198th Infantry, RVN. He had been in country 126 Days.



### **Kenneth Dee**

First Lieutenant Kenneth S Dee IN 8-69 died from an other explosive device 3 March 1970 while serving with B Co, 2nd Bn, 22nd Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 174 Days.



### **Charles Anderson**

First Lieutenant Charles Richard Anderson FA 13-69 died from hostile mortar fire 3 March 1971 while serving as pilot with B Co, 158th Aslt Helo Bn, 101st Avn Group, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 176 Days.



### **Orie Dubbeld**

First Lieutenant Orie John Dubbeld, Jr IN 501-69 died from gun or small arms fire 3 March 1971 while serving with BDQ Adv Team TD 22. ADV Team 21, HQ, MACV Advisors, RVN. He was the recipient of the Silver Star. He had been in country 332 Days.

First Lieutenant Felix E Williams IN 64-67 was awarded the Distinguished Cross for actions on 3 March 1969 while serving with Company E, 3rd Battalion, 8th Infantry, 4th Infantry Division, RVN. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2024.
