Joseph Galambos

First Lieutenant Joseph Gary Galambos IN 1-61 died from a non hostile air loss 10 April 1964 while serving with 114th AHC, Delta AVN BN, US Army Support Command Vietnam, MACV, RVN. Days in country not reported.



Leroy Webb

Second Lieutenant Leroy Boyd Webb IN 9-66 died from gun or small arms fire 10 April 1967 while serving with B Co, 5th Bn, 60th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 130 Days.



Ronald Johnson

First Lieutenant Ronald Lee Johnson IN 9-65 died from a non-hostile discharge of pistol 10 April 1967 while serving with HHC, 2nd Bn, 14th Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 140 Days.



Ronald Wojtkiewicz

First Lieutenant Ronald Joseph Wojtkiewicz AR 2-67 died from an other explosive device 10 April 1968 while serving with C TRP, 1st SQDN, 1st Cavalry, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 160 Days.
