James Conway

Major James Bennett Conway died from cause not reported 12 April 1966 while serving with Det A-253 (Duc Co), B Co, 5th Special Forces Group, RVN. For Action on this date he was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross. Days in country not reported.



Edward Harris

Second Lieutenant Edward L Harris died 12 April 1968 from wounds from unreported causes 29 February 1968 while serving with A BTRY, 3rd Bn, 82nd Artillery, 196th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 76 Days.



Stamatios Alexander

Second Lieutenant Stamatios G Alexander, Jr died from multiple fragmentation wounds 12 April 1969 while serving with B Co, 1st Bn, 27th Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 69 Days.



Corbin Tindall

First Lieutenant Corbin Clark Tindall died from multiple fragmentation wounds 12 April 1969 while serving with A Co, 2nd Bn, 12th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 48 Days.



George Adams

Captain George Hartwell Adams died from an air loss 12 April 1970 while serving with Air Cav Trp, 11th Armored Cavalry, RVN. He had been in country 347 Days.

Major James Bennett Conway was posthumously awarded the Distinguished Service Cross for actions on 12 April 1966 while serving with Det A-253 (Duc Co), B Co, 5th Special Forces Group, RVN. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2024.
