Robert Flory

First Lieutenant Robert Lester Flory, Jr died from multiple fragmentation wounds 15 April 1967 while serving with A Co, 2nd Bn, 60th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 135 Days.



Robert Lazear

First Lieutenant Robert Leroy Lazear died from gun or small arms fire 15 April 1967 while serving with B Co, 3rd Bn, 39th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 124 Days.



John O'Brien

Second Lieutenant John Joseph O'Brien died from multiple fragmentation wounds 15 April 1968 while serving with B Co, 1st Bn, 27th Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. For action on this date he was posthumously awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 16 Days.



George Economous

First Lieutenant George J Economous, Jr died from gun or small arms fire 15 April 1968 while serving with C Co, 1st Bn, 35th Infantry, 4th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 60 Days.



Robert Malone

First Lieutenant Robert Earl Malone died from an other explosive device 15 April 1968 while serving with B Co, 2nd Bn, 47th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 137 Days.



Robert Young

Captain Robert A Young, Jr died from an air loss 15 April 1969 while serving with HHC, 101st Abn Division, RVN. He had been in country 142 Days.



Ronald Montapert

Second Lieutenant Ronald M Montapert died from multiple fragmentation wounds 15 April 1969 while serving with D Co, 3rd Bn, 60th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 45 Days.
