Karl Perry

First Lieutenant Karl Frederick Perry IN 16-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 2 April 1968 while serving with A Co, 1st Bn, 2nd Infantry, 1st Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 182 Days.



Archie Hayman

Captain Archie Andrew Hayman IN 9-64 died from an air loss 2 April 1968 while serving with B TRP, 7th SQDN, 17th Cavalry, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 175 Days.



Robert Stork

First Lieutenant Robert John Stork, Jr IN 65-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 2 April 1969 while serving with HHC, Special Services Division, RVN. He had been in country 42 Days.



Thomas Gorrill

First Lieutenant Thomas Roy Gorrill FA 40A-67 died from friendly fire 2 April 1969 while serving with C BTRY, 6th BN, 77th ARTILLERY, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He was the recipient of the Silver Star. He had been in country 159 Days.



Willie Ridgeway

Captain Willie James Ridgeway FA 4-66 died from an air loss 2 April 1970 while serving with 219th AVN CO, 223rd AVN BN, 17th AVN Group, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 92 Days.



Robert Kettering

First Lieutenant Philip Robert Kettering IN 2-69 died from an other explosive device 2 April 1968 while serving with D Co, 1st Bn, 503rd Infantry, 173rd Abn Bde, RVN. He had been in country 42 Days.



Ronald Kolb

First Lieutenant Ronald Victor Kolb IN 19-69 died from gun or small arms fire 2 April 1970 while serving with 3rd PLT, C Co, 2nd Bn, 27th Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 15 Days.



Glenn Hata

First Lieutenant Glenn Lee Hata IN 5-70 died from friendly fire 2 April 1971 while serving with D Co, 1st Bn, 20th Infantry, 11th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 48 Days.
