**Walter Swain**

Captain Walter Lee Swain died from multiple fragmentation wounds 26 April 1967 while serving with D Co, 5th Bn, 7th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 267 Days.



**Herman Payne**

Second Lieutenant Herman Howard Payne died from multiple fragmentation wounds 26 April 1967 while serving with B Co, 1st Bn, 60th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. For action on this date he was posthumously awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 146 Days.



**Theodore Burton**

First Lieutenant Theodore Hughes Burton died from multiple fragmentation wounds 26 April 1968 while serving with B Co, 2nd Bn, 47th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 61 Days.



### **Charles Chandler**

Captain Charles William Chandler died from arillery, rocket, or mortar fire 26 April 1969 while serving with B Co, 1st Bn, 5th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 296 Days.



### **Edward Miles**

Captain Edward Francis Miles, Jr died from an other explosive device 26 April 1969 (Declared dead 26 Jan 2024) while serving with MACV Advisors, RVN. He had been in country 114 Days.



### **Peter Boyev**

Captain Peter Kestutis Boyev died from gun or small arms fire 26 April 1968 while serving with C Co, 1st Bn, 7th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 285 Days.



### **Tony Clough**

First Lieutenant Tony Clough died from an other explosive device 26 April 1970 while serving with 1st Plt, A Co, 3rd Bn, 506th Infantry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 182 Days.
