### Daniel Wentle

First Lieutenant Daniel Lewis Wentle IN 5-65 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 3 April 1967 while serving with DET A-351 (HIEP HOA), 5th Special Forces Group, RVN. He had been in country 77 Days.



### John Brady

Second Lieutenant John James Brady IN 35-67 died from gun or small arms fire 3 April 1968 while serving with C Co, 2nd Bn, 7th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 64 Days.



### Joseph Kube

Captain Joseph Bernard Kube IN 8-64 died from gun or small arms fire 3 April 1968 while serving with B Co, 1st Bn, 27th Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 25 Days.



### **John Wilkinson**

First Lieutenant John Terrell Wilkinson FA 25-66 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 3 April 1968 while serving with C BTRY, 2nd BN, 17th Artillery, 41st Arty Group, I Field Force, RVN. He had been in country 186 Days.



### **Francis Pearson**

First Lieutenant Francis Laury Pearson IN 42-67 died from an air loss 3 April 1969 while serving with HHC, 2nd Bn, 12th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry, RVN. He had been in country 278 Days.



### **John Wilson**

First Lieutenant John William Wilson IN 6-69 died from gun or small arms fire 3 April 1970 while serving with B Co, 2nd Bn, 506th Infantry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 327 Days.
