### Jack Whetsel

First Lieutenant Jack A Whetsel died from an other explosive device 30 April 1968 while serving with B Co, 4th Bn, 23rd Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 35 Days.



### David Feller

First Lieutenant David Kent Feller died from friendly fire 30 April 1968 while serving with H TRP, 17th Cavalry, 198th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. Days in Country not noted.



### Raymond Krupinski

First Lieutenant Raymond John Krupinski IN 6-68 died from multiple fragmentation 30 April 1969 while serving with B Co, 1st Bn, 12th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. For action on this date he was posthumously awarded the Distinguished Service Cross. He had been in country 105 Days.



### **Richard Davis**

First Lieutenant Richard Harold Davis died from gun or small arms fire 30 April 1970 while serving with ADV TEAM 84, HQ, MACV Advisors, RVN. For action on this date he was posthumously awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 343 Days.



### **John Sensing**

Captain John L Sensing died from an air loss 30 April 1970 while serving with A TRP, 2nd Squadron, 17th Cavalry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 318 Days.
