Walter Bernreuther

Captain Walter John Bernreuther IN 6-65 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 5 April 1968 while serving with C Co, 1st Bn, 35th Infantry, 4th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 94 Days.



Lars Hustad

First Lieutenant Lars Peter Hustad IN 30-67 died from non hostile undefined cause 5 April 1969 while serving with ADV Team 3, HQ, MACV Advisors, RVN. He had been in country 336 Days.



Olan Howe

Captain Olan Joseph Howe AR 32-67 died from an air loss 5 April 1970 while serving with B TRP, 2nd SQDN, 17th Cavalry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 17 Days.



John Rohr

First Lieutenant John Willard Rohr IN 520-68 died from gun or small arms fire 5 April 1970 while serving with A Co, 2nd Bn, 7th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 66 Days.

First Lieutenant Vernon J. Baker IN 148-43 was awarded the Medal of Honor for actions on 4-5 April 1945 while serving with Company C, 37th Infantry Regiment, 92nd Infantry Division, Italy. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 1999.



Thomas Davidson

◆ DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS ◆

Major Thomas A. Davidson IN 2-63 was awarded the Distinguished Cross for actions on 5-11 April 1972 while serving with Advisory Team 47, Civil Operations and Revolutionary Development Support (CORDS) Military Region 3, RVN. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2017.
