Bruce King

First Lieutenant Bruce Thomas King IN 64-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 9 April 1967 while serving with E Co, 1st Bn, 501st Infantry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 166 Days.



Edward Zager

Second Lieutenant Edward Arthur Zager FA 36A-67 died from artillery, rocket, or mortar fire 9 April 1968 while serving with C BTRY, 6th BN, 84th Artillery, 41st Arty Group, I Field Force, RVN. He had been in country 35 Days.



Thomas Leap

First Lieutenant Thomas Edward Leap, Jr IN 62-67 died from an other explosive device 9 April 1969 while serving with C Co, 2nd Bn, 16th Infantry, 1st Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 162 Days.



John Kitrilakis

First Lieutenant John Andrew Kitrilakis IN 17-69 died from artillery, rocket, or mortar fire 9 April 1970 while serving with D Co, 1st Bn, 11th Infantry, 5th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 100 Days.



John Avera

Major John Adams Avera FA 5-67 died from friendly fire 9 April 1959 while serving with ADV Team 26. HQ, MACV Advisors, RVN. He had been in country 92 Days.
