### Larry Stephan

Second Lieutenant Larry Roy Stephan IN 13-66 died from friendly fire 1 May 1968 while serving with CCo, 1st Bn, 26th Infantry, 1st Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 769 Days.



### Joseph Shreve

First Lieutenant Joseph Linwood Shreve, Jr IN 12-67 died from gun or small arms fire 1 May 1968 while serving with FOB2, HHC, 5th Special Forces Group, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 179 Days.



### Howard Crothers

First Lieutenant Howard Robert Crothers IN 16-67 died from an other explosive device 1 May 1967 while serving with A Co, 4th Bn, 31st Infantry, 196th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 55 Days.



### **Richard Sly**

First Lieutenant Richard Stephen Sly IN 65-67 died from gun or small arms fire 1 May 1968 while serving with 1st Plt, B Co, 3rd Bn, 8th Infantry, 4th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 170 Days.



### **John Tine**

Captain John Richard Tine FA 4-66 died from friendly fire 1 May 1968 while serving with ADV Team 84, HQ MACV Advisors, RVN. He had been in country 230 Days.



### **Kenneth Ross**

First Lieutenant Kenneth Edward Ross IN 60-67 died from an air loss 1 May 1968 while serving with B TRP, 3rd SQDN, 17th Cavalry, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 38 Days.
