William Sproule

First Lieutenant William C Sproule, Jr IN 16-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 10 May 1968 while serving with B Co, 3rd Bn, 503rd Infantry, 173rd Airborne Brigade, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross. He had been in country 220 Days.



Roger Duce

First Lieutenant Roger L Duce IN 65-67 died from artillery, rocket, or mortar fire 10 May 1968 while serving with B Co, 1st Bn, 6th Infantry, 198th Infantry Brigade, Amerial Division, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 128 Days.



Thomas Swann

First Lieutenant Thomas Fredrick Swann, Jr IN 65-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 10 May 1968 while serving with Det A-223 (Van Canh), B Co, 5th Special Forces Group, RVN. He had been in country 286 Days.



Eddie Molino

Captain Eddie Molino, Jr IN 19-66 died from a non hostile helicopter air loss 10 May 1968 while serving with C Trp, 7th Sqdn, 1st Cavalry, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 70 Days.



Ronald Smiley

First Lieutenant Ronald Owen Smiley IN 8-69 died from gun or small arms fire 10 May 1970 while serving with D Co, 1st Bn, 506th Infantry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 113 Days.



Kenneth Rosenberg

Captain Kenneth W Rosenberg IN 4-62 died from a helicopter non crew air crash 10 May 1968 while serving with D Co, 2nd Bn, 8th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 238 Days.

Lieutenant Colonel Weldon F Honeycutt IN 5-51 was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross for actions on 10 May 1969 while serving as Commander, 3rd Battalion, 187th Airborne Infantry, 10th Airborne Division (Airmobile), RVN. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 1972.
