William Otto

Second Lieutenant William Frederick Otto IN 4-65 died from gun or small arms fire 11 May 1966 while serving with A Co, 2nd Bn, 502nd Infantry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross. He had been in country 108 Days.



William Menconi

Second Lieutenant William Lee Menconi IN 40-67 died from gun or small arms fire 11 May 1968 while serving with A Co, 1st Bn, 6th Infantry, 1986h Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 98 Days.



Kenji Yamashita

First Lieutenant Kenji Jerry Yamashita FA 17-67 died from gun or small arms fire 11 May 1968 while serving with B Btry, 3rd Bn, 34th Artillery, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 95 Days.



Robert Ransom

Second Lieutenant Robert Crawford Ransom, Jr IN 42-67 died from an other explosive device 11 May 1968 while serving with A Co, 4th Bn, 3rd Infantry, 11th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 58 Days.



Thomas Hastings

First Lieutenant Thomas William Hastings IN 5-68 died from an other explosive device 11 May 1969 while serving with A Co, 2nd Bn, 12th Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 127 Days.



Morgan Weed

Second Lieutenant Morgan William Weed IN 18-69 died from gun or small arms fire 11 May 1970 while serving with HHC, 6th Bn, 31st Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. Or action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 127 days.



Harold Faldermeyer

Captain Harold John Faldermeyer FA 30A-67 died gun or small arms fire 11 May 1972 while serving with Adv Team 51, HQ, MACV Advisors, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross. He is also the recipient of the Silver Star. He had been in country 172 Days.



Seymour Terry

★ MEDAL OF HONOR ★

First Lieutenant Seymour W Terry IN 151-43 was posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor for actions on 11 May 1945 while serving with Company B, 382nd Infantry Regiment, 96th Infantry Division, Ryukyu Islands. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2022.
