### Omar Jones

First Lieutenant Omar David Jones IN 14-67 died from an air loss 12 May 1966 while serving with 52nd MI Detachment, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 158 Days.



### William Rogers

Captain William Francis Rogers FA 17-65 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 12 May 1968 while serving with B Btry, 6th Battalion, 77th Artillery. 25TH Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 169 Days.



### Steven Abbott

First Lieutenant Steven Glenn Abbott FA 4-67 died from an air loss 12 May 1968 while serving with HHC, 2nd Brigade, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 49 Days.



### **Adano Madrid**

First Lieutenant Adano Hernandez Madrid FA 8-67 died from gun or small arms fire 12 May 1969 while serving with Adv Team 15, HQ, MACV Advisors, RVN. He had been in country 186 Days.



### **Thomas Gentinne**

First Lieutenant Thomas Henry Gentinne IN 2-68 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 12 May 1969 while serving with Weapons Plt, a Company, 1st Battalion, 35th Infantry, 4th Infantry Division, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 127 Days.



### **Curtis Breedlove**

Second Lieutenant Curtis Breedlove IN 506-68 died from gun or small arms fire 12 May 1969 while serving with Adv Team 16, HQ, MACV Advisors, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 182 Days.



### **Raymond Dulak**

Captain Raymond R Dulak, Jr EN 38-67 died from an air loss 12 May 1970 while serving with HHC, 937th Engineer Group, 18th Engineer Brigade, USARV Engineer Command, RVN. He had been in country 417 Days.



### **Barry Mullineaux**

Captain Barry Thomas Mullineaux IN 15-67 died from an other explosive device 12 May 1970 while serving with B Co, 5th Bn, 7th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 252 Days.



### **Robert Johnson**

First Lieutenant Robert Henry Johnson IN 523-68 died from an other explosive device 12 May 1970 while serving with B Co, 4th Bn, 3rd Infantry, 11th Infantry Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 38 Days.
