Robert Waugh

First Lieutenant Robert T Waugh IN 114-42 died from gun or small arms fire 14 May 1944 while serving with the 339th Infantry Regiment, 85th Infantry Division, Italy for action on this date he was posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor.



Joseph Hailey

Captain Joseph Carlton Hailey IN 9-64 died from gun or small arms fire 14 May 1967 while serving with Adv Team 77, HQ, MACV Advisors, RVN. He had been in country 118 Days.



John DiNapoli

First Lieutenant John DiNapoli, Jr SC 18-66 died from an other explosive device 14 May 1968 while serving with HHT, 3rd Squadron, 5th Cavalry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 201 Days.



Reese Patrick

Captain Reese Michael Patrick IN 65-67 died from friendly fire 14 May 1969 while serving with I Company, 75th Infantry, 1st Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 305 Days.



Larry Weil

First Lieutenant Larry Steven Weil IN 6-68 died from gun or small arms fire 14 May 1969 while serving with C Co, 3rd Bn, 22nd Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star. Days in country not reported.



Thomas Larkin

Captain Thomas J Larkin II FA 46A-67 died from an air loss 14 May 1970 while serving with 187th Assault Helicopter Company, 269th Aviation Battalion, 12th Aviation Group, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 264 Days.
