Everett Johnson

Died from gun or small arms fire 1 February 1968 while serving with A Co, 1st Bn, 28th Infantry, 1st Infantry Division, RVN. For actions on this date he was posthumously awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 191 Days.



William Ross

Second Lieutenant William Keith Ross AR 12-67 died from friendly fire 19 May 1968 while serving with C Co, 2nd Bn, 8th Infantry, 4th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 78 Days.



Timothy Leclair

First Lieutenant Timothy Kim Le Clair IN 70-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 19 May 1969 while serving with C Co, 1st Bn, 506th Infantry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 360 Days.



John Sprewell

Captain John Spurgeon Sprewell IN 6-68 died from an air loss 19 May 1970 while serving with 135th AHC, 214th Avn Bn, 164th Aviation Group, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 306 Days.



Gary Anderson

First Lieutenant Gary John Anderson FA 515-68 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 19 May 1970 while serving with ADV Team 43, HQ, MACV Advisors, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 303 Days.



Philip Dearing

First Lieutenant Philip Ray Dearing IN 23-69 died from friendly fire 19 May 1972 while serving with ADV Team 86, HQ, MACV Advisors, RVN. He had been in country 351 Days.
