Second Lieutenant Russell Lindsey Robbins SC 9-66 died from a helicopter crew air loss 2 May 1968 while serving with 94th Sig Det, 71st AHC, 14th Avn Bn, 17th Aviation Group, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 53 Days.



George Ficklin

Second Lieutenant George Ray Ficklin FA 23-66 died from gun or small arms fire 2 May 1968 while serving with C Btry, 2nd Bn, 4th Artillery, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 112 Days.



Donald Randall

Second Donald David Randall, Jr IN 23-67 died from Artillery, rocket or mortar fire 2 May 1968 while serving with C Co, 4th Bn, 23rd Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 45 Days.



James Molpus

Second Lieutenant James Davis Molpus AR 95-67 died from artillery, rocket, or mortar fire 2 May 1968 while serving with D Co, 1st Bn, 503rd Infantry, 173rd Abn Bde, RVN. He had been in country 67 Days.



Edward Powers

Second Lieutenant Edward Claus Powers AR 30-67 died from a helicopter air loss 2 May 1968 while serving with HHT, 3rd Sqdn, 11th Armored Cavalry, RVN. He had been in country 120 Days.



James Flurry

Second Lieutenant James Durward Flurry AR 30-67 died from a Helicopter air loss 2 May 1968 while serving with C Troop, 7th Sqdn, 17th Cavalry, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 65 Days.



Frank Rice

Second Lieutenant Frank Latimer Rice, Jr EN 522-68 died from a helicopter air crew air loss 2 May 1970 while serving with 235th Avn CO, 307th Avn Bn, 164th Aviation Group, 1st Aviation Brigade. For action on this date he was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross, RVN. He had been in country 11 Days.



John Becker

Second Lieutenant John Paul Becker IN 10-69 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 2 May 1968 while serving with B Co, 4th Bn, 31st Infantry, 196th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 147 Days.



Richard Brewer

Second Lieutenant Richard Dennis Brewer IN 518-68 died from a helicopter air loss 2 May 1968 while serving with A TRP, 1st SQDN, 9th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 70 Days.



Dale Richardson

Major Dale W Richardson FA 3-66 died from an a helicopter non crew loss 2 May 1970 while serving with D Co, 2nd Bn, 34th Armor, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. Days in country not reported.
