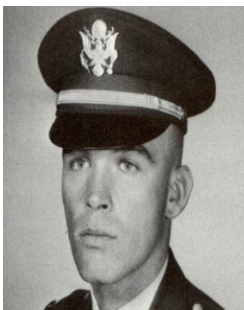

Thomas Burke

First Lieutenant Thomas James Burke IN 3-66 died from an undefined cause 22 May 1967 while serving with B Company, 3rd Battalion, 12th Infantry, 173rd Abn Bde, RVN. He had been in country 234 Days.



Harold Ford

Second Lieutenant Harold Andrew Ford IN 18-66 died from an multiple fragmentation wounds 22 May 1967 while serving with A Co, 3rd Battalion, 12th Infantry, 4th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 23 Days.



Joe Hines

First Lieutenant Joe Raymond Hines AR 13-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 22 May 1968 while serving with A Co, 1st Bn, 5th Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 81 Days.



John Huestis

Second Lieutenant John Edward Huestis FA 515-68 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 22 May 1969 while serving with A Battery, 1st Battalion, 11th Artillery, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 85 Days.



Gary Mower

First Lieutenant Gary Ruel Mower IN 18-69 died from an other explosive device 22 May 1970 while serving with C Co, 5th Battalion, 46th Infantry, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 139 Days.



Neil Hayes

First Lieutenant Neil Burgess Hayes, Jr IN 21-69 died from an air loss 22 May 1970 while serving with C Company, 1st Bn, 52nd Infantry, 198th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 62 Days.
