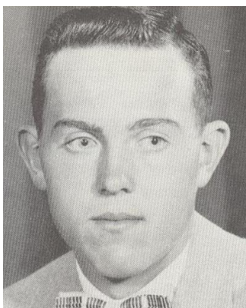
Fleming Brainerd

Captain Fleming Bukey Brainerd III FA 4-56 died from Gun or small arms fire 26 May 1965 while serving with DET A5-224 (Phu Tuc), 5th Special Forces Group, US Army Support Command Vietnam, MACV, RVN. He had been in country 48 Days.



Edward Fisher

First Lieutenant Edward Stephan Fisher IN 1-66 died from a non hostile air loss 26 May 1968 while serving with A Company, 1st Bn, 8th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 83 Days.



Jack Dodson

First Lieutenant Jack Leroy Dodson IN 2-65 died from an air loss 26 May 1967 while serving with 191st Assault Helicopter Company, 214th Aviation Battalion, 12th Aviation Group, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. For action on this date he was posthumously awarded the Air Medal with V. He had been in country 4 Days.



Clayton Johnson

First Lieutenant Clayton Winslow Johnson IN 2-66 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 26 May 1967 while serving with C Company, 3rd Battalion, 8th Infantry, 4th Infantry Division, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star, He had been in country 253 Days.



Harold Clifford

Second Lieutenant Harold John Clifford IN 56-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 26 May 1968 while serving with C Company, 1st Battalion, 52nd Infantry, 198th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 59 Days.



Philip Gamble

Second Lieutenant Philip Lyle Gamble, Jr IN 512-68 died from gun or small arms fire 26 May 1969 while serving with A Company, 2nd Battalion, 1st Infantry, 196th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. For action on this he was awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 49 Days.



Robert Sigholtz

Captain Robert H Sigholtz, Jr IN 49-67 died from gun or small arms fire 26 May 1969 while serving with D Co, 2nd Battalion, 503rd Infantry, 173rd Abn Bde, RVN. He had been in country 277 Days.



Robert McCurdy

Captain Robert Lowell McCurdy IN 3-63 died from gun or small arms fire 26 May 1970 while serving with D Co, 1st Bn, 46th Infantry, Americal Division, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 42 Days.



Kenneth Scully

First Lieutenant Kenneth William Scully IN 14-69 undefined non-hostile cause 26 May 1968 while serving with D Co, 1st Bn, 503rd Infantry, 173rd Abn Bde, RVN. He had been in country 21 Days.
