Joseph Caudillo

Captain Joseph Caudillo IN 3-62 died from gun or small arms fire 3 May 1967 while serving with C Co, 1st Bn, 35th Infantry, 173rd Abn Bde, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 238 Days.



Norville Henn

Captain Norville Martin Henn, Jr FA 28-66 died from an other explosive device 3 May 1968 while serving with ADV Team 80, HQ, MACV Advisors, RVN. He had been in country 167 Days.



James Treesh

Captain James M Treesh AR 25-66 died from gun or small arms fire 3 May 1970 while serving with D Co, 1st Bn, 503rd Infantry, 173rd Abn Bde, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 44 Days.



Derrill Burnside

Captain Philip Derrill Lee Burnside FA 7-67 died from a helicopter air loss 3 May 1968 while serving with 3rd SQDN, 5th Cavalry, 1st Brigade, 5th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 42 Days.



Fredrick Ransbottom

Major Fredrick Joel Ransbottom IN 32-67 died from unreported cause 3 May 1979 from wounds received 12 May 1968 while serving with Recon PLT, E Co, 2nd Bn, 1st Infantry, 196th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star. Days in country not reported.
