Oscar Biehl

Captain Oscar Biehl, Jr IN 52-53 died from gun or small arms fire 30 May 1967 while serving with Detachment A-221 (Cung Son), 5th Special Forces Group, RVN. He had been in country 124 Days.



Andrew Young

First Lieutenant Andrew Kung Young AR 9-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 30 May 1968 while serving with D Co, 3rd Battalion, 12th Infantry, 4th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 93 Days.



Joseph Clinch

First Lieutenant Joseph R Clinch IN 16-69 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 30 May 1970 while serving with B Company, 3rd Battalion, 187th Infantry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 218 Days.



William Gay

First Lieutenant William E Gay, Jr IN 8-69 died from other causes undefined 30 May 1968 while serving with E Co, 3rd Battalion , 22nd Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 219 Days.
