Second Lieutenant George Patrick Rogers AR 9-66 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 7 May 1967 while serving with B Trp, 3rd Sqdn, 4th Cavalry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. Days in country not reported.



Roy McDonald

First Lieutenant Roy Lawrence McDonald IN 4-68 died from an accident 7 May 1969 while serving with HHC, 2nd Bde, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 129 Days.



Terry Baxter

First Lieutenant Terry D Baxter IN 16-69 died from gun or small arms fire 7 May 1970 while serving with D Co, 1st Bn, 503rd Infantry, 173rd Abn Bde, RVN. He had been in country 194 Days.



Lawrence Fletcher

First Lieutenant Lawrence Eugene Fletcher IN 16-69 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 7 May 1970 while serving with 2nd Plt, D Co, 1st Bn, 506th Infantry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 195 Days.



Frank Bengtson

First Lieutenant Frank W Bengtson FA 9-71 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 7 May 1967 while serving with A Trp, 1st Sqdn, 9th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 259 Days.
