**John Vaughan**

Second Lieutenant John W. Vaughan QM 26-66 died in the crash of a C-130 aircraft on 17 June 1967 while serving with HHC, U.S. Army Support Command Qui Nhon, 1st Logistical Command, RVN. He had been in country 157 days.



**Edward Strombeck**

Major Edward Earl Strombeck IN 6-57 died in the crash of a C-130 aircraft on 17 June 1967 while serving with Advisory Team 22, Military Assistance Command RVN. He had been in country 336 days.



**James Schueller**

First Lieutenant James Patrick Schueller FA 10-65 died in a C-130 aircraft crash on 17 June 1967 while serving with B Battery, 2nd Battalion, 17th Field Artillery, 1st Cavalry Division. He had been in country 336 days.



### **Douglas Logan**

First Lieutenant Douglas Alfred Logan IN 110-66 died from fragmentation wounds received 17 June 1967 while serving with Reconnaissance Platoon, HHC, 1st Battalion, 16th Infantry, 1st Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 186 days.



### **Charles Bedsole**

First Lieutenant Charles Arthur Bedsole FA 8-67 died from hostile small arms fire on 17 June 1968 while serving with Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, 3rd Battalion, 319th Field Artillery, 173rd Airborne Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 163 days.



### **Larry Martin**

First Lieutenant Larry Raymond Martin EN 505-67 died from wounds suffered from a hostile explosive device on 17 June 1969 while serving with Company B, 26th Combat Engineer Battalion (Divisional), Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 227 days.



### **Jerry Ashburn**

First Lieutenant Jerry Allen Ashburn AR 31-67 died from wounds suffered from a hostile explosive device on 17 June 1969 while serving with Company D, 2nd Battalion, 12th Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. The number of days he was in country is not recorded.
