Robert Jones

First Lieutenant Robert Lewis Jones IN 16-67 died from an air loss 2 June 1968 while serving with D Company, 229th Assault Helicopter Battalion, 11th Aviation Group, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 207 Days.



Clem Giles

First Lieutenant Clem Calvin Giles IN 25-67 died from gun or small arms fire 2 June 1968 while serving with D Company, 2nd Battalion, 18th Infantry, 1st Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 59 Days.



Donald Porter

First Lieutenant Donald John Porter AR 29-67 died from an air loss 2 June 1969 while serving with C Troop, 1st Squadron, 9th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. For action on this date he was posthumously awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 90 Days.



Robert Poxon

First Lieutenant Robert Leslie Poxon AR 28-67 died from gun or small arms fire 2 June 1970 while serving with Aero Rifle Platoon, B Troop, 1st Squadron, 9th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. For action on this date he was posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor. He had been in country 235 Days.



James Stokes

First Lieutenant James Michael Stokes IN 9-69 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 2 June 1970 while serving with A Company, 2nd Battalion, 7th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. Days in country not reported.



Frederick Suttle

Captain Frederick N Suttle, Jr AR 4-67 died from an air loss 2 June 1972 while serving with H Troop, 10th Cavalry, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 187 Days.

Kenneth Brown

◆ DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS ◆

Captain Kenneth E Brown IN 130-42 was posthumously awarded the Distinguished Service Cross for actions on 1-2 June 1952 while serving as Commanding Officer Company L, 3rd Battalion, 24th Infantry Regiment, 25th Infantry Division, Korea. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2024.



James Mapp

◆ DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS ◆

Second Lieutenant James Howell Mapp IN XX-51 was awarded the Distinguished Cross for actions on 1-2 June 1952 while serving with Company A, 1st Battalion, 26th Infantry, 1st Brigade, 1st Infantry Division, RVN. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 1979.



Robert Poxon

★ MEDAL OF HONOR ★

First Lieutenant Robert L Poxon AR 28-67 was awarded the Medal of Honor for actions on 2 June 1969 while serving with Aero Rifle Platoon, B Troop, 1st Squadron, 9th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2016.
