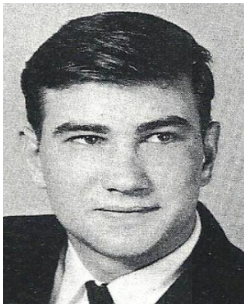

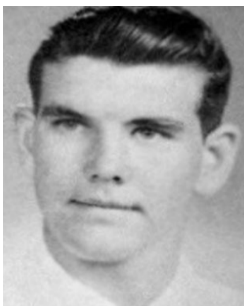
**Lonnie Clements**

First Lieutenant Lonnie Edwards Clements IN 10-64 died from gun or small arms fire on 20 June 1966 while serving with Detachment A-326, 5th Special Forces Group, RVN. He had been in country 79 days.



**Bernard Pierce**

First Lieutenant Bernard Lawrence Pierce AR 30-67 died from multiple hostile fragmentation wounds on 19 June 1969 while serving with Troop I, 3rd Squadron, 11th Armored Cavalry Regiment, RVN. He had been in country 257 days.



**Brian Heath**

First Lieutenant Brian Charles Heath IN 3-68 died of wounds received by hostile indirect fire on 20 June 1969 while serving with Company D, 1st Battalion, 61st Infantry, 5th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 312 days.



### **Daniel DeSocio**

First Lieutenant Daniel Joseph DeSocio IN 20-69 died as the victim of a homicide by a Vietnamese Regional Forces soldier on 20 June 1970 while serving with Advisory Team 37, Military Assistance Command Vietnam, RVN. He had been in country 52 days.



### **Marlin Miller**

First Lieutenant Marlin McClelland Miller IN 37-69 died of non-hostile causes on 20 June 1971 while serving with Company A, 3rd Battalion, 1st Infantry, 11th Infantry Brigade, American Division, RVN. He had been in country 222 days.



### **Louis Breuer**

First Lieutenant Louis Karl Breuer IV FA 19-70 died from injuries received in the crash of an aircraft lost to enemy fire on 20 June 1972 while serving with Troop F, 9th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 270 days.
