Second Lieutenant William Peter Wagner, III IN 12-66 died from wounds received by hostile fire on 21 June 1967 while serving with Company B, 1st Battalion, 5th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 109 days.

First Lieutenant Thomas Edwards Campbell FA 12-65 died from an aircraft crash due to hostile fire on 21 June 1967 while serving with the Troop C, 1st Squadron, 9th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 90 days.
