#### **Ervin Burns**

First Lieutenant Ervin L Burns IN 3-66 died from hostile fragmentation wounds on 22 June 1967 while serving with Company A, 2nd Battalion, 503rd Infantry, 173rd Airborne Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 33 days.



#### **Jeffery Sexton**

Second Lieutenant Jeffery Ross Sexton IN 14-66 died from hostile fragmentation wounds on 22 June 1967 while serving with Company A, 2nd Battalion, 503rd Infantry, 173rd Airborne Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 109 days.



#### **Michael Parmerter**

Captain Michael James Parmerter FA 21-67 died from other/non-combat causes on 22 June 1969 while serving with Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 173rd Airborne Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 467 days.



**Gail Furrow**

◆ DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS ◆

Captain Gail W. Furrow IN 35-67 was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross for actions on 22 June 1972 while serving as the Senior Advisor to the Army of the Republic of Vietnam's 11th Airborne Battalion, Airborne Division. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2024.
