Second Lieutenant Daniel Keith Wapinski IN 518-68 died from fragmentation wounds suffered as a result of hostile action on 29 June 1969 while serving with Company D, 1st Battalion, 502nd Infantry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 57 days.

Second Lieutenant Robert Duane Paulus IN 516-68 died from hostile gun or small arms fire on 29 June 1969 while serving with Company D, 1st Battalion, 502nd Infantry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 57 days.



Alan Horn

Second Lieutenant Alan Murray Horn IN 520-68 died from hostile gun or small arms fire on 29 June 1969 while serving with Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 1st Battalion, 12th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 25 days.



Calvin Binder

Second Lieutenant Daniel Keith Wapinski IN 518-68 died from fragmentation wounds suffered as a result of hostile action on 29 June 1969 while serving with Company D, 1st Battalion, 502nd Infantry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 57 days.
