**Thomas Fowler**

Second Lieutenant Thomas Weldon Fowler AR 33-43 died from small arms fire 3 June 1944 while serving with the 191st Tank Battalion, 1st Armored Division, Italy. He had previously been awarded the Medal of Honor.



**Lowell Morgan**

Major Lowell Edward Morgan IN 2-60 died from a non hostile air loss 3 June 1967 while serving with 73rd Aviation Company, 210th Aviation Battalion, 12th Aviation Group, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 287 Days.



**Steven Gillmer**

First Lieutenant Steven Martin Gillmer IN 25-67 died from gun or small arms fire 3 June 1968 while serving with 2nd Platoon, C Company, 1st Bn, 35th Infantry, 4th Infantry Division, RVN. For action on this date he was posthumously awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 51 Days.



### **Anthony O'Reilly**

First Lieutenant Anthony Paul O'Reilly IN 17-66 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 3 June 1968 while serving with A Company, 2nd Battalion, 39th Infantry, 9th Infantry Division, RVN. For action on this date he was posthumously awarded the Distinguished Service Cross. He had been in country 188 Days.



### **Herman Hantz**

First Lieutenant Herman Eugene Hantz IN 15-67 died from gun or small arms fire 3 June 1968 while serving with Detachment A-361, A Company, 5th Special Forces Group, RVN. He had been in country 107 Days.



### **Michael Wilson**

Second Lieutenant Michael Lund Wilson IN 50-67 died from multiplication fragmentation wounds 3 June 1968 while serving with C Company, 1st Battalion, 6th Infantry, 198th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 180 Days.



### **Richard Watson**

Captain Richard Wayne Watson EN 12-67 died from an air loss 3 June 1969 while serving with F Troop, 8th Cavalry, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 385 Days.



### **Charles Vale**

Second Lieutenant Charles Vale IN 69-67 died from an air loss 3 June 1969 while serving with HHC, 2nd Brigade, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 60 Days.



### **Steven Schimmel**

First Lieutenant Stephen George Schimmel IN 66-67 died from an air loss 3 June 1969 while serving with 219th Aviation Company, 223rd Aviation Battalion, 17th Aviation Group, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 64 Days.



### **John Hughes**

Captain John S Hughes, Jr FA 24-66 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 3 June 1970 while serving with Advisory Team 64, Headquarters MACV Advisors, RVN. He had been in country 36 Days.
