Jimmie Monteith

First Lieutenant Jimmie W Monteith, Jr IN 23-42 died from small arms fire 6 June 1944 while serving with Company L 3rd Battalion, 16th Infantry Regiment, 1st Infantry Division, France. For action on this date he was posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor.



Richard Holt

First Lieutenant Richard Ancil Holt IN 25-67 died from fun or small arms fire 6 June 1968 while serving with D Company, 3rd Battalion, 21st Infantry, 196th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 52 Days.



James Wood

First Lieutenant James Schenler Wood IN 28-67 died from gun or small arms fire 6 June 1968 while serving with A Company, 4th Battalion, 9th Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 49 Days.



Richard Rudolph

First Lieutenant Richard Joseph Rudolph IN 28-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 6 June 1968 while serving with A Company, 4th Battalion, 9th Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 48 Days.



Harris Folmar

Second Lieutenant Harris Alan Folmar IN 59-67 died from an other explosive device 6 June 1968 while serving with A Company, 4th Battalion, 25th Infantry, 11th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. He had been in country 55 Days.



Duane Landwehr

Second Lieutenant Duane Henry Landwehr IN 512-68 died from undefined cause 6 June 1969 while serving with B Company, 4th Battalion, 23rd Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 36 Days.



Leo Marcoulier

Captain Leo R Marcoulier FA 3-59 died from artillery, rocket or mortar fire 6 June 1969 while serving with HHB, 7th Battalion, 11th Artillery, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. Days in country not reported.



Larry Barbee

First Lieutenant Larry Hulan Barbee IN 51-67 died from multiple fragmentation wounds 6 June 1969 while serving with B Company, 2nd Battalion, 2nd Infantry, 1st Infantry, RVN. For action on this date he was awarded the Silver Star. He had been in country 281 Days.



Joseph Breski

First Lieutenant Joseph Breski, Jr AR 31-67 died from an air loss 6 June 1969 while serving with B Troop, 1st Squadron, 9th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 63 Days.



William Byrd

Captain William Larry Byrd IN 6-68 died from an air loss 6 June 1970 while serving with HHC, 2nd Battalion, 14th Infantry, 25th Infantry Division. He had been in country 353 Days.

◆ DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS ◆

First Lieutenant Richard D Winters IN 27-42 was awarded the Distinguished Cross for actions on 6 June 1944 while serving with Company E, 2nd Battalion, 506th Parachute Infantry Regiment, 101st Airborne Division, France. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2005.



Jimmie Monteith

◆ DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS ◆

First Lieutenant Jimmie W Monteith, Jr IN 23-42 was posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor for actions on 6 June 1944 while serving with Company L 3rd Battalion, 16th Infantry Regiment, 1st Infantry Division, France. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 1959.
