First Lieutenant Richard Carl Knack IN 27-67 died from friendly fire 7 June 1968 while serving with 3rd Platoon, B Company, 28th Infantry, 1st Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 37 Days.



Michael Hope

Captain Michael Clint Hope SC 2-67 died from an air loss 7 June 1970 while serving with 74th Aviation Company, 210th Aviation Battalion, 12th Aviation Battalion, 12th Aviation Group, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had been in country 768 Days.



Robert Robertson

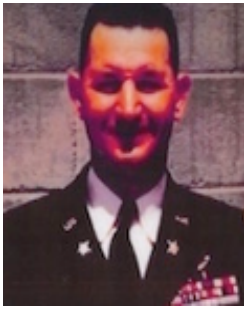
Captain Robert Allan Robertson FA 15-69 died from a non-hostile air loss 7 June 1972 while serving with Army Installation Pleiku, RVN. He had been in country 197 Days.

Eugene Doerfler

◆ DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS ◆

Second Lieutenant Eugene A Doerfler IN 50-42 was awarded the Distinguished Cross for actions on 7 June 1944 while serving with Headquarters, 2nd Battalion, 505th Parachute Infantry Regiment, 82nd Airborne Division, France. He is also the recipient of the Silver Star. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 1962.



John Synowsky

◆ DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS ◆

Second Lieutenant John Synowsky IN 165-43 was awarded the Distinguished Cross for actions on 7 June 1944 while serving with Company F, 2nd Battalion, 18th Infantry Regiment, 1st Infantry Division, France. He is also the recipient of the Silver Star. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2019.



George Ring

◆ DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS ◆

Second Lieutenant George Michael Ring IN 11-67 was awarded the Distinguished Cross for actions on 7 June 1968 while serving with Company C, 2nd Battalion, 12th Cavalry, 3rd Brigade, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He was inducted into the OCS Hall of Fame in 2004.
