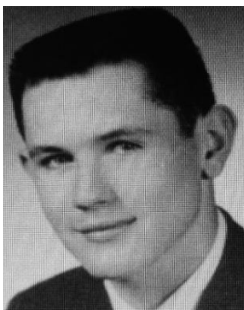

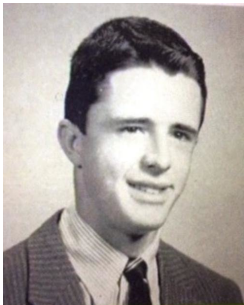
Stanley Patterson

First Lieutenant Stanley Fredrick Patterson IN 7-66 died from multiple hostile fragmentation wounds on 7 July 1967 while serving with Company C, 4th Battalion, 23rd Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 52 days.



Floyd Holifield

First Lieutenant Floyd Holifield, Jr. IN 2-66 died from hostile small arms fire on 7 July 1967 while serving with Company B, 4th Battalion, 23rd Infantry, 25th Infantry Division, RVN. He had been in country 132 days.



Thomas Derosier

Captain Thomas Albert Derosier IN 3-63 died in an aircraft lost to hostile fire on 7 July 1967 while serving with the 187th Assault Helicopter Company, 269th Aviation Battalion, 12th Aviation Group, 1st Aviation Brigade, RVN. He had 138 days in country.



Charles Dickey

First Lieutenant Charles Joseph Dickey IN 34-67 died from multiple hostile fragmentation wounds on 7 July 1968 while serving with Company B, 1st Battalion, 5th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division, RVN. He had been in country 143 days.



John Holton

First Lieutenant John Thomas Holton, Jr. IN 45-67 died as the result of an explosive device on 7 July 1968 while serving with Company A, 1st Battalion, 501st Infantry, 101st Airborne Division, RVN. He had been in country 206 days.



Steven Brooks

First Lieutenant Steven Karl Brooks IN 56-67 died as the result of an explosive device on 7 July 1969 while serving with Company A, 1st Battalion, 52nd Infantry, 198th Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, RVN. He had 590 days in country.
